Payment

Payment will be calculated monthly and due at the first lesson of the month. In the case of special circumstances, weekly lesson payment will still be accepted. Lessons will not be given in the absence of payment. If you have an irregular weekly lesson time, it is recommended and requested that you book each month's worth of lessons in advance on the website or via email.

Cancellation Policies

One week notice is required if a lesson needs to be cancelled or rescheduled. To reschedule a lesson, you may book a lesson on my website or via email. Please do not cancel lessons last minute unless there is an emergency. A lesson cancelled for non-emergency reasons within 24 hours will still be responsible for payment.
